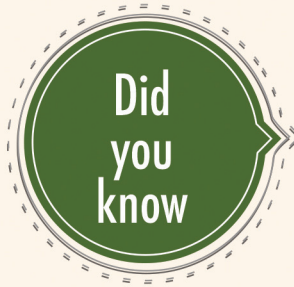
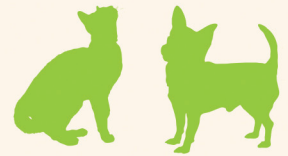


Infographic: Protect Your Pets from these Common Poisonous Plants

If you feel your pet might have been poisoned by one of these plants, please contact Island Animal Hospital, or your nearest animal hospital, immediately.

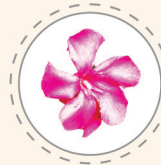
